If you could buy only one book about Linux 2.x and its associated software, Red Hat Linux 6 Server would make an excellent choice. This book deals with all aspects of the Red Hat 6 distribution of the operating system that's brought about a sea change in the computer and networking industries.Mohammed Kabir, a programmer and an expert on the Apache server, has written a book that's patient and easy to follow, yet detailed and packed with information you'll need to get yourself out of jams. Though more information on Gnome and other graphical environments would make this book better, Kabir's coverage of the basics--installation, configuration, basic networking, workaday commands, and the file system--is very good.This book distinguishes itself from its pack of competitors with its coverage of server software, however. A large part of this book deals with the installation, configuration, and use of various servers, including those for the Domain Name System (DNS), electronic mail, Web documents, SQL databases, and FTP documents.The author's style seems almost joyous at times. He'll typically explain how to do something in the standard way, then begin to rattle off variations on

that theme: "You might want to do this! Or this! Or--oh, watch this--this!" This sort of presentation is a lot of fun to read, and it makes the reader aware of exactly how flexible the Linux environment can be under the control of a knowledgeable handler. does not do it justice. The text was clear and easy to read. When I ordered it I imagined I would need a magnifying glass. Each topic has space to write your own items into that section, [3 lines]. There is also a section at the end for a unique list of your own. There are quite some funny comments on the back of the pad, so it's hard to see if the comment ... with over 59 sheets is satire or not. Either way at 1 sheet a week it's over a year's supply. A great Bargain!"

Puppycontroller, "Good but rather American. This is a great idea, spoiled only slightly by the US design not being quite right for my UK shopping habits. The items are organised neatly on the page and, once you've got used to where things are, this is a smart way to keep track of what needs replenishing in the kitchen. Don't use the last section which is for extra items not found elsewhere on the list. It's better to write things in the section (e.g. dairy) where they belong or you'll spend even longer trekking around the supermarket, back and forth!"
