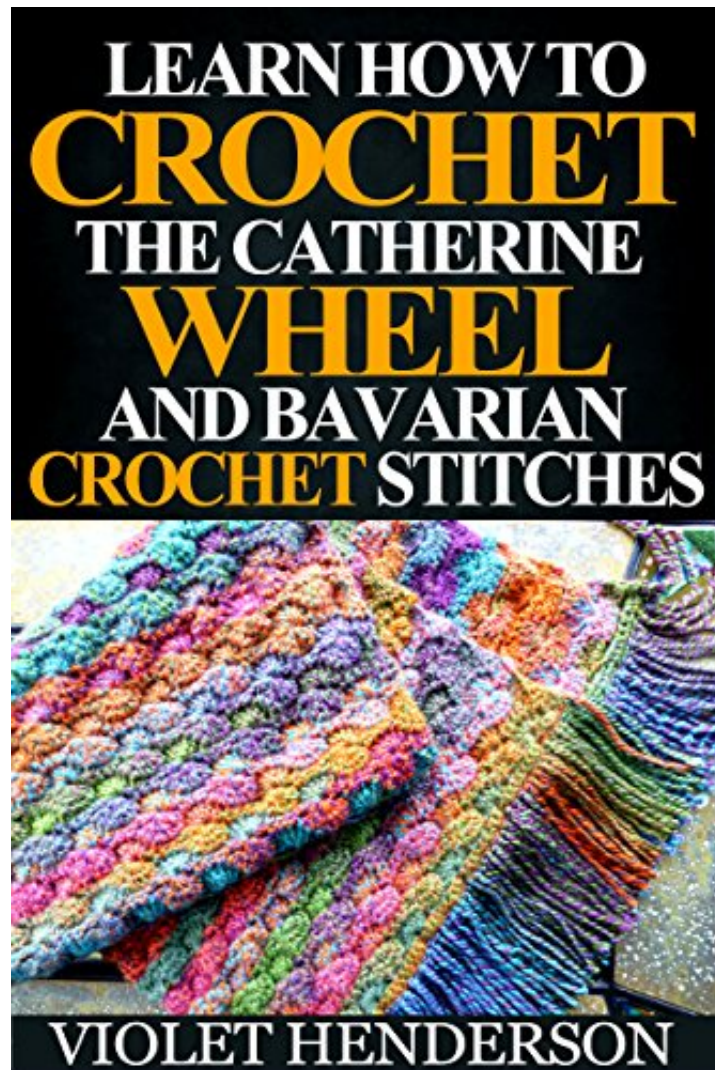


# Crochet: Learn How to Crochet the Catherine Wheel and Bavarian Crochet Stitches
