Each page is placed below a mountain photograph page. The pages are fourteen by eleven inches. Each day in the calendar grid has its own 1-7/8 by 1-7/8 inch box, leaving sufficient space for notes. Astronomical events and holidays are indicated. I recommend this calendar for anyone who is a fourteener fanatic or who likes mountain photographs.
