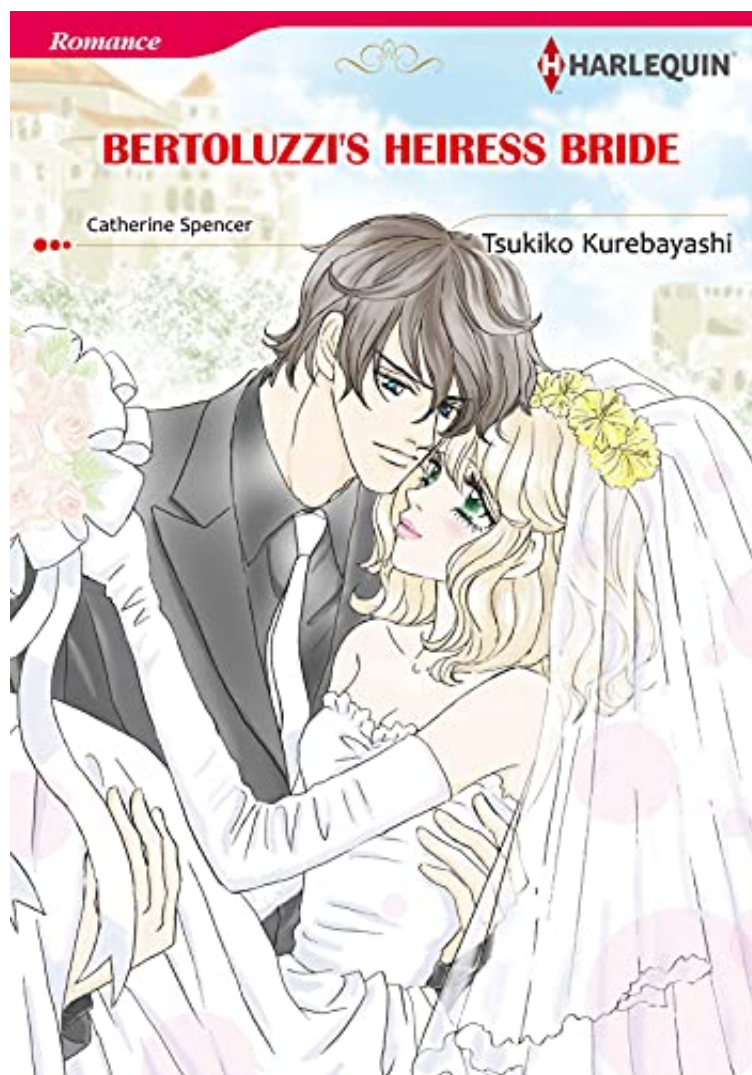


BERTOLUZZI'S HEIRESS BRIDE (Harlequin Comics)

The more experienced man finds the girl attractive but knows he must stay away from her. He's got enough problems, having inherited the villa after years of keeping his nose clean and running a construction firm. I liked both characters and the grandmother too, and thought the landscape which I have visited, was well described. This was a pleasant short read and I would read more by this author."
