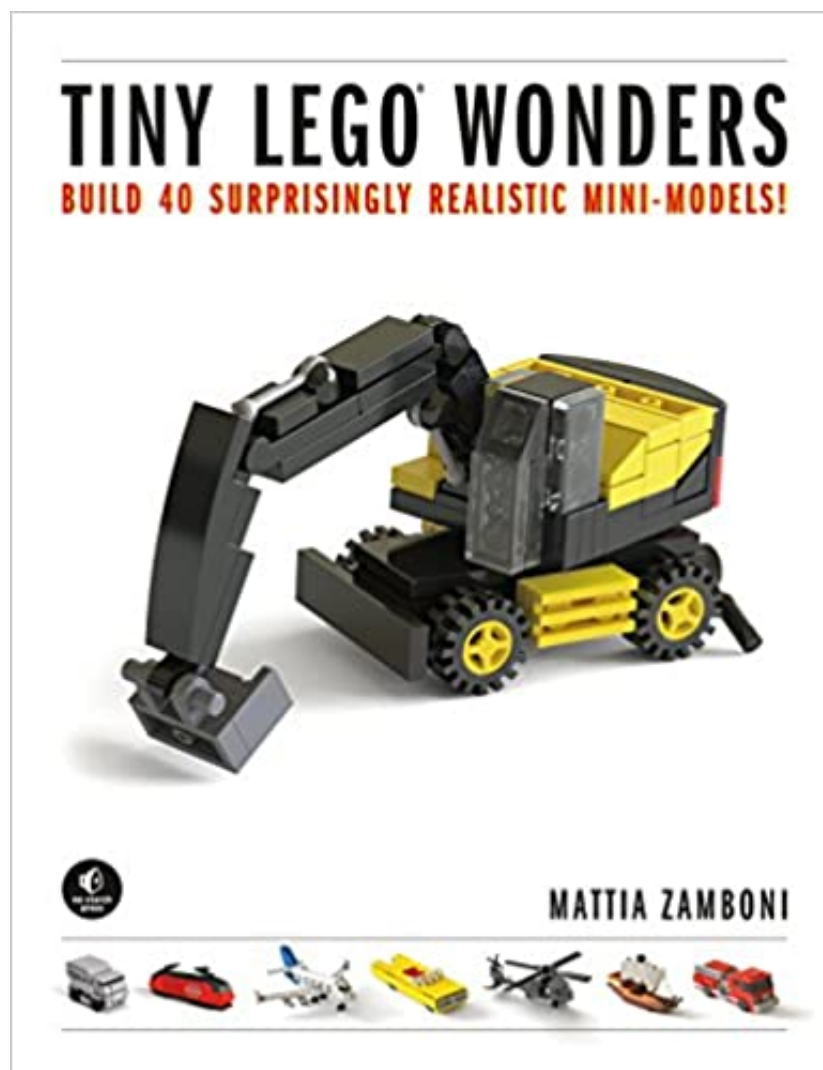

Some Guy Who Buys Stuff, "Great micro Lego vehicle idea book, with a star removed for lack of piece information.. This is a great micro Lego build book, with some fantastic ideas for micro vehicles. I have a few qualms (people have already mentioned a few in the reviews before this one), but not with the models, instead with the piece/build information that was added (apparently after the fact).i.e. on pp 136 (which you have to find page 135 and then go forward one, because ALL of the Bill of Material pages do not have page numbers, the rest of them do) you have a great list of pieces, but do not get the LEGO design IDs or BOIDs, so when you get to a strange piece o7 good luck trying to find it.Also, another minus for use of custom stickers, and CGI to show lights (although possible to do with LEDs on the bus for example, you'll have a hard time jamming everything in the limited space), give a bit of a false advertising, as you're not going to get that when you build the pieces.The models are great, the reliance on weird, uncommon pieces, lack of piece information (how about adding a few pieces to the book so you can actually make one of them?), CGI and custom stickers, make a great book, more of an 'this is just for ideas, you should probably want til it goes on sale' book."

msrpres, "Good book but some errors. The models are well designed and nice to build. The models have a surprising amount of detail given the scale. Some of the models have build errors (i.e. F-15 Eagle does not have studs which align properly). Would still recommend the book but hope the author releases a errata for this book"

Should have been titled "Tiny Lego Vehicles". Maybe they'll do one dedicated to architecture or other topics (hope so).That said, the micro builds here are great. Like any other Lego project book you're gonna need the specific pieces to build *exactly* what's in the book, but you can usually get

fairly close if you have a decent collection of kits and pieces. Lots of good inspiration in the book.”
